I WAY TO LOOK AT ARCHITECTURAL SPACE IS NOT CONSIDERING IT SIMPLY AS A "VOID" MATERIAL FOR A SPECIAL KIND OF SCULP - TURE, BUT CONSIDER IT AS A "CONTAINER" WITHIN WHICH SIGNIFICANT EQUIPMENT IS STORED AND USED.

LLY PROPOSAL, IN THE SO-IES, OF WHAT I CALLED THE "MEUBLE+"
CONSIDERED THE POSSIBILITY TO ASSOCIATE TO ALL KIND OF
EQUIPMENT (FURNITURE, MEUBLE) A BOX CONTAINING IT AND
THE BARTICULAR SPACE NECESSARY FOR ITS USE.

THUS A TABLE WITH PLACE TO SIT AROUND, A "DINER BOX", A BED WITH SPACE TO CENTER LUTO, A CABINE WITH SHOWER AND SINK A PLANE WITH COOKERS AND SINK, A "KITCHEN CABINE", ETC COULD BE PUSHED AROUND AS ORDINARY FURNITURE.

THESE "MEVBLES +" WOULD BE CONTAINED WITHIN A GENERAL "SCULP TURED" SPACE VOLUME, THEY COULD BE DISPOSED BY THE INHABITANT, WHO COULD CHANGE THE PATTERN ("FLOUR PLAN") WHECH DEFINED THE PLACE OF THESE "KABINES".

THE ETFECTIVE FLOOR AREA OF SLICH A "CABINE" WOULD BE NOT MODE THAN A M2 EACH (2Mx 2M). FOR A GROUP OF INHABI-TANTS (LE-A FAMILY OF A) THE GLOBAL AREA OF A+4+2 CABINES WOULD BE ABOUT AD M2. A "CONTAINING SPACE" OF ABOUT BO M2 WOULD EASILY PERMIT A LARGE "MULTI-USE" AREA OF 40 M2 OF VARIABLE SHAPE IT COULD ONE DAY FORM A LARGE "ROOM" (OR HALL), ON OTHER OCCASIONS STAVE AS ACCESS CORRIDORS TO THE CABINES AND INDIVIDUAL "NICHES" FOR EACH INHABITANT-

TRANSFORMATION OF OWE SUCH PATITED NINTS ANOTHER COULD BE EFFECTUATED WITH ABOUT 1 HOUD OF WORK FOR CHANGING THE PLACE OF DIFFERENT CABINES.

MOBILE" ARCHITECTURE, ACCORDING, THIS PROPOSITION, COULD BECOME EVERYDAY PRACTICE. IT WOULD ACHIEVE INHABITANT-HAND-LING OF BOTH FOR THE "VOID-SCULPTURE" AND FOR THE FUNCTION WAL DISPOSITION. OF EQUIPMENT.

TECHNICALLY, A "SPACE-CHAIN" CUBICLE (6 DINGS, ABOUT 15 KG THE WHOLE) COULD SERVE AS UNIT BOX FOR THE "MEVBLE +" CONCERTION OF ARCHITECTURE.
